KY Graduate Profile - 10 Essential Skills

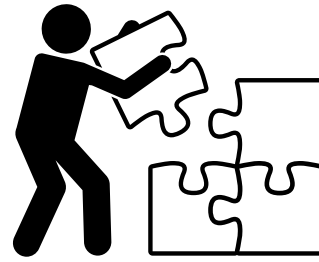

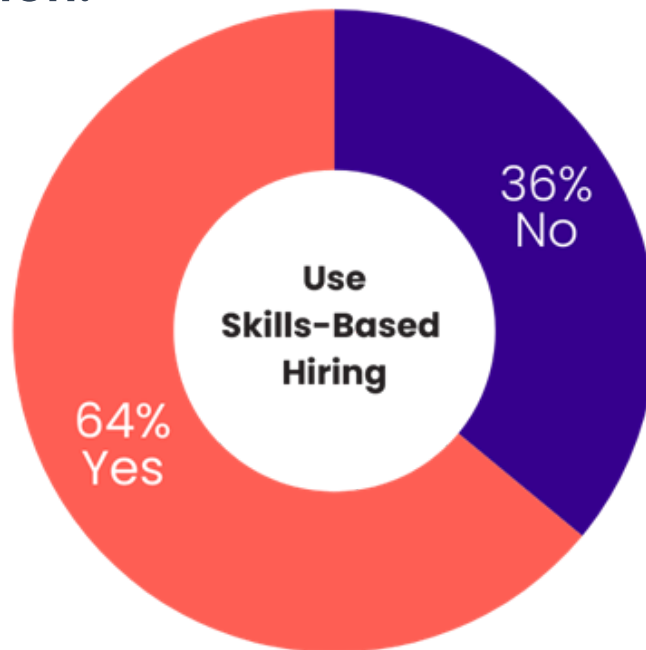
